The application has been referred to Scottish Ministers and the decision of Scottish Ministers will be final. In connection with the service of notice, your attention is drawn to section 271 of the 1997 Act.

Grateful for your Council to serve the required notice and issue me with a copy. There is also a requirement to include a copy of the decision to call in on the planning register in accordance with Regulation 16 and paragraph 3 (d) of Schedule 2.

In terms of the Town and Country Planning (Appeals) (Scotland) Regulations 2013, the application will be submitted to the Directorate for Planning and Environmental Appeals (DPEA) in Falkirk for an examination by a Reporter.
