THE TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING (NOTIFICATION OF RECEIPT OF APPLICATIONS) (COMMERCIAL EXTRACTION OF PEATLAND) DIRECTION 2021

Scottish Ministers, give the following Direction in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Regulation 31 and 32 of the Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (Scotland) Regulations 2013 and all other powers enabling them to do so:

1. Information to be given to Scottish Ministers

When a planning authority receives an application for the commercial extraction of peatland, it must give Scottish Ministers the following information—

- The planning application reference;
- The address or location of the development; and
- A description of the development.
- 2. The Scottish Government would expect that the information sent to Scottish Ministers, is provided electronically by means of a link, or series of links to the relevant case file on the authority's website.

Reason for the Direction

3. This Direction is given to allow the Scottish Ministers to monitor planning applications for commercial peatland extraction, in view of the national importance of peatlands and peatland restoration in contributing to the objective of addressing climate change.
