

How long has the SHS been running?



The Scottish Household Survey (SHS) has run continuously in Scotland since devolution in 1999. This means trends over time can be measured.



SHS: the child of devolution

- Scotland voted to re-establish the Scottish Parliament in 1997:
 - A few specialist surveys in Scotland...
 - SHCS from '91, SCS from '94, SHeS from '95
- Preparations for the new Scottish Parliament highlighted need for more data in Scotland:
 - Most GB / UK surveys had small (but proportionate) Scottish samples
 - Most stopped at the Caledonian Canal
 - Content and coverage decided by ONS in London with little influence from Scotland
- A new general purpose survey for Scotland, modelled on the General Household Survey:
 - Cross-cutting
 - Evidence-led

Since 1999...

- **268,071 household interviews** (as of yesterday)

- 400,000 people in total including the random adult interviews

- Or one interviewer,

- interviewing 24 hours a day,

- for seven days a week,

- continuously for

- **25 years!**


