SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1927. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly be submitted.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1927 comprised 3,286 sailing vessels, 1,927 motor vessels, 820 steam drifters, 4 steam mussel dredgers, 43 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 319 steam trawlers, or a total of 6,399 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,920,586, as against 6,551 vessels and £3,957,669 in 1926. In addition 249 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 25,677 (of whom 6,436 were crofter fishermen and 1,002 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 26,344 (including 6,586 crofter fishermen and 963 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 67,471, as against 66,844 in 1926.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 6,919,920 cwts., valued at £4,369,968, besides shell-fish valued at £93,421, as against 6,460,807 cwts., £4,349,205 and £98,316 respectively in 1926. In addition 786,376 cwts., valued at £370,936, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 941,245 cwts. and £440,618 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 7,706,296 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £4,834,325, as compared with 7,402,052 cwts. and £4,838,139 in 1926. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 4,235,467 cwts., valued at £1,746,922, against 4,020,202 cwts. and £1,734,312.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 1,171,757 barrels (of which 965,193 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £2,709,473, against a total of 1,124,305 barrels valued at £2,641,914 in 1926. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 543,664 cwts., valued at £1,065,667, as against 489,695 cwts. and £990,297 in 1926.

The exports of fish from Scotland comprised 987,956 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 6,127 barrels ungutted, and 193,140 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 903,890 barrels, 1,461 barrels, and 154,977 crans respectively in 1926, and 318,310 cwts. of dried or pickled fish of other kinds, and 16,579 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 300,451 cwts. and 21,042 cwts. respectively in 1926.
