SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1929. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly be submitted.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1929 comprised 2,994 sailing vessels, 1,961 motor vessels, 807 steam drifters, 3 steam mussel dredgers, 35 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 329 steam trawlers, or a total of 6,129 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,963,360, as against 6,216 vessels and £3,891,762 in 1928. In addition 283 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 24,670 (of whom 6,145 were crofter fishermen and 848 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 25,043 (including 6,295 crofter fishermen and 937 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 66,552, as against 66,676 in 1928.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 6,774,036 cwts., valued at £4,672,916, besides shell-fish valued at £100,783, as against 6,603,770 cwts., £4,658,100 and £97,974 respectively in 1928. In addition 677,075 cwts., valued at £343,687, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 729,448 cwts. and £431,657 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 7,451,111 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £5,117,386, as compared with 7,333,218 cwts. and £5,187,731 in 1928. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 4,073,046 cwts., valued at £1,706,554 against 4,011,224 cwts. and £1,824,066.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 1,249,059 barrels (of which 1,087,603 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £2,816,382, against a total of 1,135,778 barrels valued at £2,764,603 in 1928. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 521,747 cwts., valued at £1,125,878, as against 625,344 cwts. and £1,235,573 in 1928.

The exports of fish from Scotland comprised 1,087,172 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 4,285 barrels ungutted, and 87,204 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 954,974 barrels, 1,169 barrels, and 141,097 crans respectively in 1928, and 302,349 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of other kinds, 10,235 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, and 11,070 cwts. of sprats iced and sprinkled, as against 332,797 cwts., 16,654 cwts., and 1,713 cwts. respectively in 1928.
