SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1933. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly follow.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1933 comprised 2,428 sailing vessels, 2,280 motor vessels, 733 steam drifters, 2 steam mussel dredgers, 24 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 327 steam trawlers, or a total of 5,794 vessels, valued with their gear at £3,236,338, as against 5,846 vessels and £3,522,587 in 1932. In addition 292 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 23,066 (of whom 5,590 were crofter fishermen and 916 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 23,622 (including 5,675 crofter fishermen and 859 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 58,780, as against 60,369 in 1932.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 5,028,279 cwts., valued at £3,518,905, besides shell-fish valued at £94,025, as against 5,750,693 cwts., £3,711,105 and £89,487 respectively in 1932. In addition 455,767 cwts., valued at £172,529, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 553,925 cwts. and £183,798 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 5,484,046 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £3,785,459, as compared with 6,304,618 cwts. and £3,984,390 in 1932. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 2,256,379 cwts., valued at £1,129,149, against 2,930,978 cwts. and £1,292,898.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 601,258 barrels (of which 473,051 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £1,482,663, against a total of 701,122 barrels valued at £1,734,742 in 1932. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 446,560 cwts., valued at £986,137, as against 434,755 cwts. and £947,946 in 1932.

The exports of fish from Scotland included 455,193 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, none ungutted, and ~~20,375~~ crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 563,866 barrels, 784 barrels, and 210,668 crans respectively in 1932, and 161,240 cwts. of dried, smoked, or pickled fish of other kinds, and 12,553 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 181,117 cwts. and 13,151 cwts. respectively in 1932.
