**Additional Case Information:**

Site not holding lobsters for aquaculture purposes and no plans to hold. Although containers for holding lobsters still on site, some pipe work has been removed and the pump for system was not operational. As the lobster facilities were in the larger unit operated by Scotlive, the intention was to move the main operation of business in to this larger unit, using equipment from smaller unit to get this one operational. Main area of business is langoustines.

Site does receive lobsters, but these were reported to be low numbers and not held for long and aren't reported to be fed on site.

Site has undergone a change in management.

As site is not undertaking lobster aquaculture, the site will be deregistered.

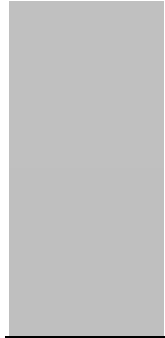

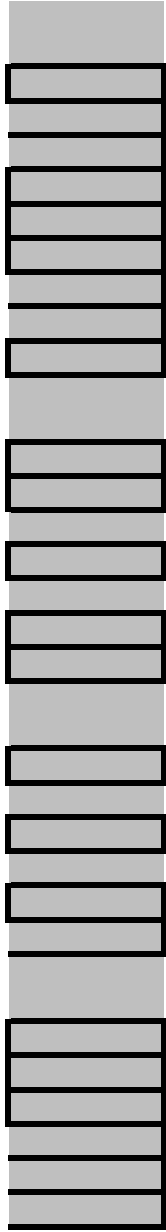

The above site was inspected in accordance with the Aquatic Animal Health (Scotland) Regulations 2009.

On this occasion, the site was found to be fallow. It was reported that there are no plans to restock the site with European lobsters (*Homarus gammarus*) at this time and the lobster holding facilities were inoperable.

As the site is not currently operational and there are no plans to undertake lobster aquaculture the Aquaculture Production Business (APB) and site are to be deregistered. You will receive a separate communication regarding deregistration of the APB.
