Here you go, sorry for the delay.

A Transport Scotland spokesman said:

“Draft orders were published in 1996, however the scheme was held in abeyance following the Strategic Roads Review in 1999. Our Consultant is currently reviewing previous work, including the route published in draft in 1996, in line with current design standards, environmental constraints and legislation, together with comments received following the publication of the previous draft orders.

“In addition, our Consultant is developing alternative routes which will be assessed along with the routes developed in the 1990s. As part of the assessment process of all trunk road improvement schemes, we are obliged to investigate and appraise all feasible options.


“At this stage there is no preferred route. A public consultation exercise will be undertaken prior to the establishment of a preferred route in order that local people can contribute to the assessment.

“Suggestions that we have started to look at a new route in connection with the proposed Donald Trump development are inaccurate.”
