
**A consultation on the next generation of national qualifications in Scotland.**

BIAB, as the leading awarding body for the licensed retail sector, is very interested in contributing to the above consultation. We do not, however, feel able to do so, due to the following factors:

- There does not appear to be any acknowledgement of the widening array of qualifications offered in Scotland that are not primarily based in schools. Many of these, although not SVQs, are SQA accredited and SCQF credit rated, although some are still offered outside of these frameworks, due to the tight criteria for accreditation that is currently applied.
- Any plans for articulation with frameworks in England, Wales and Northern Ireland are not mentioned, although will have major impact on the situation with regard to:
  - The wider Skills Agenda
  - The relationship with the 14-19 Diplomas and transportability of credits/achievements
  - The relationships between the SCQF, the QCF and the EQF
- There is no way to register the existence of other qualifications applicable to schools, such as the BIAB Scottish Certificate in Alcohol Awareness
