I would like to contribute to the consultation on the proposals for a Scottish Climate Change Bill. I welcome strong legislation to reduce greenhouse gas emissions, and would like to see the Bill include strong, measurable targets.

1. The target for reduction of greenhouse gas emissions should be a minimum of 80% by 2050, with statutory targets of at least 3% year on year emission reductions. This should include aviation and shipping emissions

2. I would like to see tangible financial support for householders to install green energy generation such as solar power and wind turbines, with a target of achieving the level of micro generation achieved by other European countries, such as Germany, within 10 years.
