At the recent meeting of BCC, members discussed the above proposals and broadly support action to ameliorate the potential effects of Global Climate Change.

We are, however, very aware that many of the proposed steps to help reduce the impact of any such environmental consequences have to be "world-wide" and need a unified, structured effort from ALL nations - not just those signed up to Kyoto agreements - but all nations.

Without that consensus, a purely Scottish effort would be worthless and damaging to the Scottish economy.

There would, of course, be considerable benefits nationally to a "greener" environmental policy.
