<i>Inspection Details</i>	:	Records of the trial were examined and discussed. The crop was drilled on 26 August 2001. The preparation of the drill and subsequent cleaning after sowing were performed according to the conditions of the consent. No spillage of seed was recorded. Surplus seed was labelled and stored securely and collected by a representative of the consent holder on 25 September 2001. The control crop for the trial was the conventional variety Herald. A field inspection was conducted. The area of the GM Crop (6 ha) and approximate number GM plants released (49 plants per m ²) were checked. Field markers located the 50 metre separation distance on the control side of the field. There were no sexually compatible crops with which oilseed rape could cross-pollinate in the adjacent fields. Winter barley was to the north/north -east of the GM crop and grass was to the west/north-west.
<i>Report Conclusions</i>	:	The FSE trial was being run to a good agronomic standard. The trial was being run in accordance with the conditions of the consent. No issues of harm to either human health or the environment were identified.
<i>Action Taken</i>	:	None required.

Inspection Details	:	<p>The Inspectorate discussed the harvest of the trial crop and conducted a site inspection.</p> <p>The crop was swathed and harvested on during August 2002 according to the conditions of the consent. The separation distance was measured by the consent holder and the harvested material from both the GM and separation distance were disposed of to landfill.</p> <p>The combine harvester was cleaned out at the farm prior to harvesting the non-GM crop outwith the separation distance. All material from the combine was placed in the bags destined for landfill.</p> <p>The consent holder provided landfill receipts from the disposal company indicating that the oilseed rape seed had been disposed of to an approved landfill site.</p> <p>After harvested the field was ploughed then sown with winter barley in early September. The winter barley crop received a post emergence herbicide spray for volunteer oilseed rape control.</p> <p>During the site inspection the no oilseed rape volunteers were seen.</p> <p>The field had been regularly monitored by one of the consent holder's specialist agronomists.</p>
Report Conclusions	:	The trial site was being managed in accordance with the conditions of the consent. No issues of harm to either human health or the environment were identified.
Action Taken	:	None required.
