<b>Inspection Details</b>	:	Records of the trial were examined and discussed.  A representative of Aventis was present during the sowing of the GM Crop. The drilling of the GM Crop was undertaken under difficult circumstances where some members of the public had attempted to impede sowing. After drilling had been completed, the drill was checked to ensure there was no seed on any of the ledges and then sealed. The hopper was shut off, ensuring no seed could escape from either the hopper or the drill. The drill was cleaned off site at a nearby steading. No spillage was recorded. Excess seed was labelled and stored securely and collected by the consent holder on 26 September 2001.  A field inspection was conducted. The area of the GM Crop (14 ha) and approximate number of GM plants released (average of 48 plants m <sup>2</sup> ) were checked.  There were no sexually compatible crops with which oilseed rape could cross-pollinate in the adjacent fields. On one side of the GM crop there was an unploughed field which, it was reported, will not be planted until the spring.
<b>Report Conclusions</b>	:	The FSE trial was being run to a good agronomic standard. The trial was being run in accordance with the conditions of the consent. No issues of harm to either human health or the environment were identified.
<b>Action Taken</b>	:	1. In the spring of 2002, the Inspectorate will confirm the species of a crop which has still to be planted in adjacent field to the GM crop.

<b><i>Inspection Details</i></b>	:	<p>The crop was harvested in August 2002. Harvested seed was bagged in the field for disposal to landfill. The combine was cleaned in the field on the same area as the bagging of the seed had been carried out.</p> <p>The Inspectorate received landfill disposal certificates indicating that the harvested Oilseed Rape had been collected and disposed of in a licensed landfill site in 3 lots.</p> <p>The site had been ploughed and sown with winter wheat. Herbicides had been applied. No volunteers were detected in the field at the time of inspection.</p>
<b><i>Report Conclusions</i></b>	:	The trial site was being managed in accordance with the conditions of the consent. No issues of harm to either human health or the environment were identified.
