<b><i>Inspection Details</i></b>	:	<p>The trial was situated in the location indicated by SAC. The site was readily identifiable and could be accurately located by triangulation using a map provided by SAC.</p> <p>Trial records are kept in a trial diary. This was inspected and found to be satisfactory.</p> <p>The trial plots sown on 11.09.02 according to the National List requirements met the requirements of the consent. The trial was terminated prior to the inspection visit. Termination took place on 10.03.02 by rotavation. At termination the crop was very small with only three true leaves.</p> <p>A decision on the crop rotation for the site following termination of the GM trial had yet to be taken. The Inspectorate asked for confirmation of the site management when the decision had been taken by SAC.</p> <p>The inspectors inspected the terminated trial site and found no signs of any oilseed rape plants remaining on the site following rotavation.</p>
<b><i>Report Conclusions</i></b>	:	The trial was being conducted in accordance with the conditions of the consent. No risks to human health or the environment were identified.
<b><i>Action Taken</i></b>	:	The Inspectorate asked SAC to confirm the follow on management for the site.
