I spoke with Philippe Gadda from DTI earlier today and was able to find out some background information on the energy modelling and CBA workstreams. The lead economist is Elisabeth Cuthbertson; Philippe is responsible for the energy modelling; while Henry Shaerman is undertaking the CBA. Their work began in December and they started off modelling the "do nothing" scenario projecting current trends and policies and looking into energy demand and carbon emissions in 2020 (intermediate stage) and 2050 (White Paper horizon). The CBA has been conducted at the same time due to time constraints but they intend to put together the two workstreams in April and start looking at the policy implications. They hope the exercise will be finished by May at the latest. He offered to send me more information though this hasn't arrived as yet.
