**Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 of the European Parliament and of the Council of  
3 October 2002 laying down health rules concerning animal by-products not  
intended for human consumption**

**The Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003**

**Approval of collection centres**

In accordance with Regulations 25, 26 and 27 of the Animal By-Products (Scotland) Regulations 2003 and Article 23 of Regulation (EC) No 1774/2002 the Scottish Ministers approve as collection centres –

- (a) knackers' yards approved under the Animal By-Products Order 1999 on 30 September 2003; and
- (b) premises registered under the Animal By-Products Order 1999 on 30 September 2003 to use animal by-products for feeding to recognised packs of hounds.

For each premises this approval ceases to apply either when those premises are inspected and an Approval is either granted or refused, or on 1 January 2004, whichever is the earlier.

This approval operates from 1 October 2003.
