#### Dear Chief Executive,

- 1. AGGREGATE EXTERNAL FINANCE FOR 2002-03
- 2. REDETERMINATION OF REVENUE SUPPORT GRANT FOR 2001-02
- 1. The Local Government Finance (Scotland) Order 2002 was debated and approved by the Scottish Parliament on 31 January. This Circular provides authorities with a summary of the figures contained in that Order.

#### Aggregate External Finance 2002-03

- 2. Finance Circular 8/2001, issued on 6 December 2001, covered Scottish Ministers' initial proposals for the distribution of AEF for 2002-03. Subsequent revisions were notified to you in my letter of 17 December. The resulting allocations were approved by Parliament on 31 January 2002, and are shown in Annex A to this circular. Annex B summarises the breakdown of total AEF for 2002-03 and replaces Annex 1 to Circular 8/2001.
- 3. Local authorities will remember that a supplement to the "Green Book" *Grant Aided Expenditure 2001-02* describing the basis of the Estimated Service Expenditure calculations underpinning the provisional AEF allocations for 2002-03 and 2003-04 was issued at the time the current three year settlement was announced. Annex C updates the supplement to reflect the additional resources included in the allocations for 2002-03 approved by the Parliament.

### Additional Allocations 2002-03

4. Discussions are on-going between the Scottish Executive and COSLA about the allocation of additional funding for 2002-03, including for the implementation of the new arrangements for personal and nursing care for older people; care home fees, enhanced debt advice services and fire pensions. We hope to confirm the allocations for individual authorities and arrangements for paying the funds during 2002-03 shortly.

#### Redetermination of RSG for 2001-02

- 5. The Local Government Finance Order also redetermined RSG for 2001-02 to take account of the following changes, which were considered at the meeting between Ministers and COSLA office bearers on 14 January 2002:
  - £2 million additional funding for supporting people;
  - £0.8 million additional funding for refund of registration fees;
  - £2.7 million additional funding to improve adult literacy and numeracy;
  - £2 million additional funding for out of school care;
  - £17.5 million additional funding for care home fees;
  - additional funding for the Excellence Fund;
  - adjustments to loan charge support resulting from changes to Ppp project details; (further details were provided to Norie Williamson at COSLA on 7 February)
  - £6.4 million transfers from capital to revenue for West Lothian Council, Midlothian Council and Argyll & Bute Council;
  - £1 million allocated from the Modernising Government Fund to 3 councils;
  - £0.5 million funding to 15 councils to offset the additional costs of rates relief for foot & mouth disease;
  - £20 million allocated to 9 councils from the Better Neighbourhoods Services Fund.
- 6. Annex D shows in more detail the changes to each council's ESE for 2001-02. Annex E summarises the adjustments that will be made to RSG/NDRI payments for 27 March as a result of the redetermination of RSG for 2001-02. Revised payment profiles for 2001-02 and payment profiles for 2002-03 will be sent to councils shortly.
