Comments The current Scheme lost credibility once CoSLA ended its annual review of fees. This led to disparity in rates for safeguarders around the country as it was left to individual authorities to fix their own payment rates. So a safeguarder working in more than one local authority area could well find that the payment rates for essentially the same work varied significantly between areas. This clearly had implications for recruitment and retention of safeguarders, and was a headache for anyone involved in administering the Scheme.  Safeguarders are an important constituent part of the national Children's Hearings System. It is essential that the Fee Scheme be standardised across Scotland, so restoring credibility to that system.
