I would question the inclusion of what looks like an extension to the Robin Rigg windfarm when it has previously been rejected as unsuitable for further offshore wind development, by the Scottish Government. The operators of Robin Rigg have not expressed an interest in this site extension (to my

knowledge) so I would ask why the Government would appear to be operating a back door policy in including this site in this document when it has been previously ruled out, and is the only previously rejected site to appear.

As a general comment, I believe there is an urgent requirement for a coordinated review of all renewables developments in Scotland, to ensure the correct balance is being achieved, the appropriate energy generation targets will be met and that the drive for energy is not sacrificing our environment, landscape and local industries such as tourism. Wind turbines seem to be "flavour of the month" and are funded as such. There are surely other possibilities eg building every new house/house extension with solar panels which are efficient, impact less on the landscape and still contribute to the drive for reduction in power generated by non renewable sources.
