I have had a brief look at the above, and would make the following comments, which I hope are of value

Q1 The draft circular appears, a robust endeavor at the difficult task of integrating the, by definition, videly - focused concerns of land use planning with the objective economic & environmental concerns of marine planning; in particular, the emphasis placed on <u>aligning timescales</u> is to be welcomed.

Q2 The draft circular appears to set out the requirements for integration between land use and marine planning, and in particular, places emphasis on the need for sensitive consideration of those <u>issues outlined</u> in paragraph 35.

Q3 The detail of the draft circular outlined in paragraphs 30 - 39 inclusive appears to provide detail of good practice, particularly with regard to timescale & (potentially sensitive) categories of development.

The consultation might well, want to have regard to the emergant <u>'Lerwick Declaration'</u>, following representations made by Shetland, Orkney and Comhairle nan Eilean Sar in, 'Our Islands - Our Future'.

I would describe my ' Area of Interest ' as ' Recreation / Tourism '.
