	Performance Targets (pages 17& 18) We think it is important to show how the performance targets would link to the Scottish National Outcomes and link to other Scottish Government outcomes, for example, the Housing and Re-generation targets. At the moment we cannot explicitly see how these links will be made.
	The regulations have a strong focus on the whole system therefore it is important that the performance targets and outcomes are not considered in isolation and that all key partners and sectors are included.

	For example:
	The Housing (Scotland) Act 1987 – Section 5 We cannot see how section 5 in isolation relates back to the functions that will remain with the local authority. We are also unclear about how this section relates to the list of functions listed on page 29.
	The Housing Scotland Act 2001 – Section 92 While we understand that some of the functions contained in section 92 could be delegated to the joint body, it does not appear clear as it stands at the moment.
