Good for businesses and their employees



Of the £329 million that Scottish Government spent through its contracts, around £106 million went directly to SMEs. Many more SMEs also won work in our supply chains as subcontractors. These subcontractors shared at least £75 million of work, with Scottish SMEs receiving at least £23 million of that.

Good for society



As well as continuing to support thousands of existing jobs, our contracts enabled the creation of **146** brand-new jobs, **27** apprenticeships, **31** work placements and **453** qualifications.

Good for places and communities



We awarded **21 new contracts** with community benefits incorporated. This brings the total number of live contracts with community benefits to **62**.

Open and Connected



Across Scotland, **over 450 organisations** used Public Contracts Scotland (PCS) to advertise **11,025 contract opportunities** resulting in **15,656 suppliers** winning contracts.
