

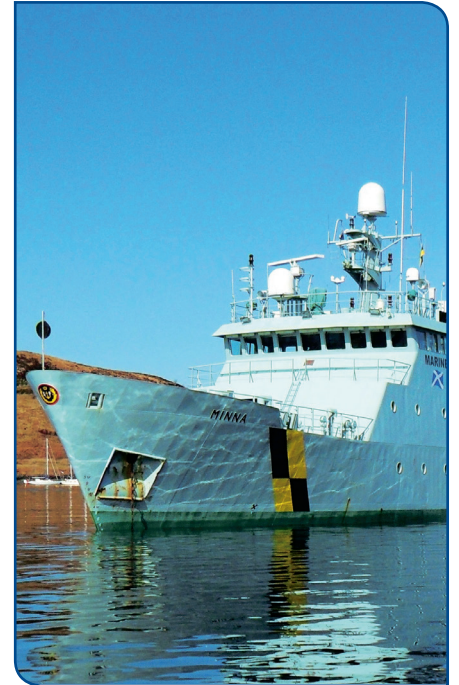

### Background

The role of Compliance is to manage the coastal, sea and air assets of Marine Scotland, and to ensure compliance with international, EU and UK legislation and regulations in the marine environment around Scotland out to 200 miles (and beyond when required).

### Assets

Marine Scotland's marine surveillance capability is made up of three Marine Protection Vessels (MPVs) and two CESSNA F406 aircraft, which are all tasked by the Enforcement and Surveillance Unit in Victoria Quay, Edinburgh.

### Marine Fleet

Marine Protection Vessel *Jura* is the first in her class and was launched in 2005. Her sister ship, *MPV Hirta*, was commissioned into service in March 2008. The third vessel, *MPV Minna* was commissioned in 2003.

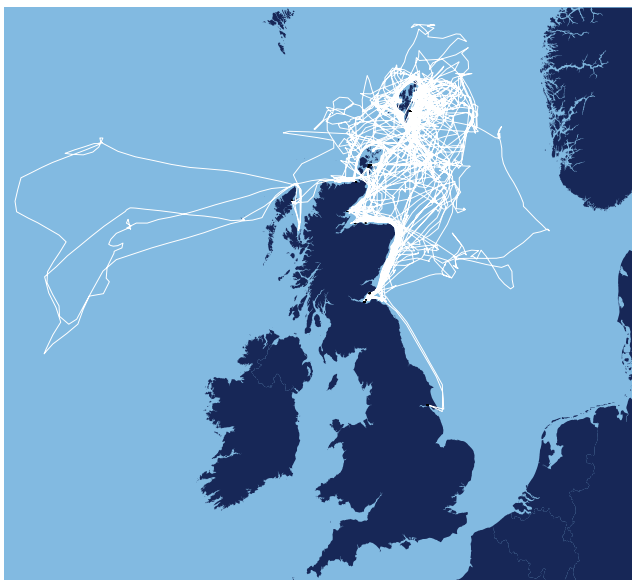
Protection vessels are deployed for 315 days each year on marine monitoring and enforcement duties in the Scottish zone of the 200 mile British Fishery Limits.

They are also occasionally deployed into the Norwegian Sea and into the Atlantic, west of Rockall, in support of the North East Atlantic Fisheries Convention (NEAFC). NEAFC aims to regulate fishing activity in international waters in the north east Atlantic area.

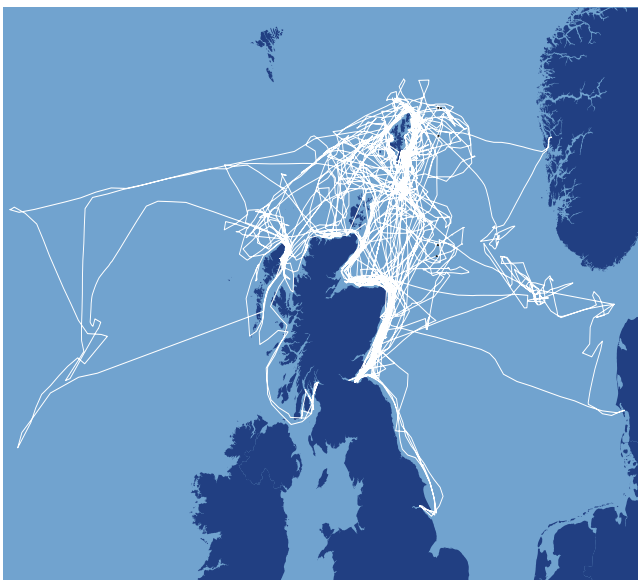
EXAMPLE OF MPV *HIRTA* CRUISE TRACK

- CREW:** 17 - 8 officers, 2 catering, 7 ratings (inc moterman)

Marine Protection Vessel *Minna* the smallest of the Protection vessels, concentrates on inshore fisheries.

**LENGTH:** 47 metres

**TONNAGE:** 781 gross tonnes

**PROPULSION:** Wärtsilä -diesel Electric Variable propulsion - 1600 kw single bow thruster

**SPEED:** Single screw variable pitch - 14 knots

**BOATS:** 1 Delta 6.8 boarding boat

**CREW:** 15 - 6 officers, 9 ratings
