- o Would we aim to ask both the main applicant and the applicant partner?

2) To add a 'Private Residential Tenancy' option to 'outcomes'

• Add the option of Private Residential Tenancy to 'Short Secure Tenancy'

Areas of discussion:

- Is it realistic to collect information on the specific type of tenancy agreement, or could there be an alternative of using a general "private rented sector" option?
- 3) From last HSUG 'Statisticians to consider revising the Prevent 1 data spec to include 'Mortgage to rent' on to Outcome category.

Areas of discussion:

- Is this something that should also be added to HL1 outcomes?
- If 'Mortgage to rent' is not available as an option then what other category would these outcomes be recorded under?
