## Review of Information Governance: Research and Statistics

## **Outline "Ask" of Data Delivery Group**

- 1. That the Data Delivery Group acknowledge the rationale for the Review of Information Governance for Research and Statistics and its place within the wider High Level Delivery Plan.
- 2. On this basis, that the DDG endorse our proposal to convene a Steering Group to oversee the development of proposals to be taken to Scottish Ministers - outlining options and recommendations for an improved IG Framework governing the use of public sector data for public benefit research and statistics in Scotland.
- 3. That the role and membership of the proposed Steering Group and Working Group be as set out in the enclosed Terms of Reference.
- 4. That the DDG acknowledge the dual reporting structure which exists over the subset of Domain B of the Health and Care Digital Strategy relating to IG for research and statistics; in practice colleagues in Digital Health leading this programme will work with Data, Statistics and Digital Identity Division under the current Review.

Health and Care Digital Strategy provides:

"Domain B" sets out a programme of activities for delivering by 2020 a simplified and consistent national approach for Information Assurance, Governance and Security, which will take into account the different needs of users and citizens, and provide clarity around information sharing across health and care.
