Who we are and what we do

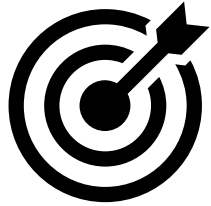


- Investing in property, natural resources and people to generate lasting value for Scotland.
- Scottish Crown Estate spans length and breadth of Scotland. Includes rural estates, commercial property, mineral and salmon fishing rights, just under half of the foreshore and almost all of the seabed.
- Return all revenue profit to Scottish Government.

Strategic Management Plan for the Scottish Crown Estate

- Scottish Ministers are currently seeking views on the first Strategic Management Plan for the Scottish Crown Estate – a requirement of the Scottish Crown Estate Act 2019.
- Plan includes a vision and an overarching set of objectives, priorities and policies for managing the assets sustainably and inclusively.
- These principles have been designed to align with Scottish Ministers' wider objectives, priorities and policies over the next five years and beyond.
- The Plan will guide and support those with responsibility for the management of Scottish Crown Estate assets now and in the future.
- Consultation closes on Friday 22 November 2019; Plan expected to be finalised in early 2020.

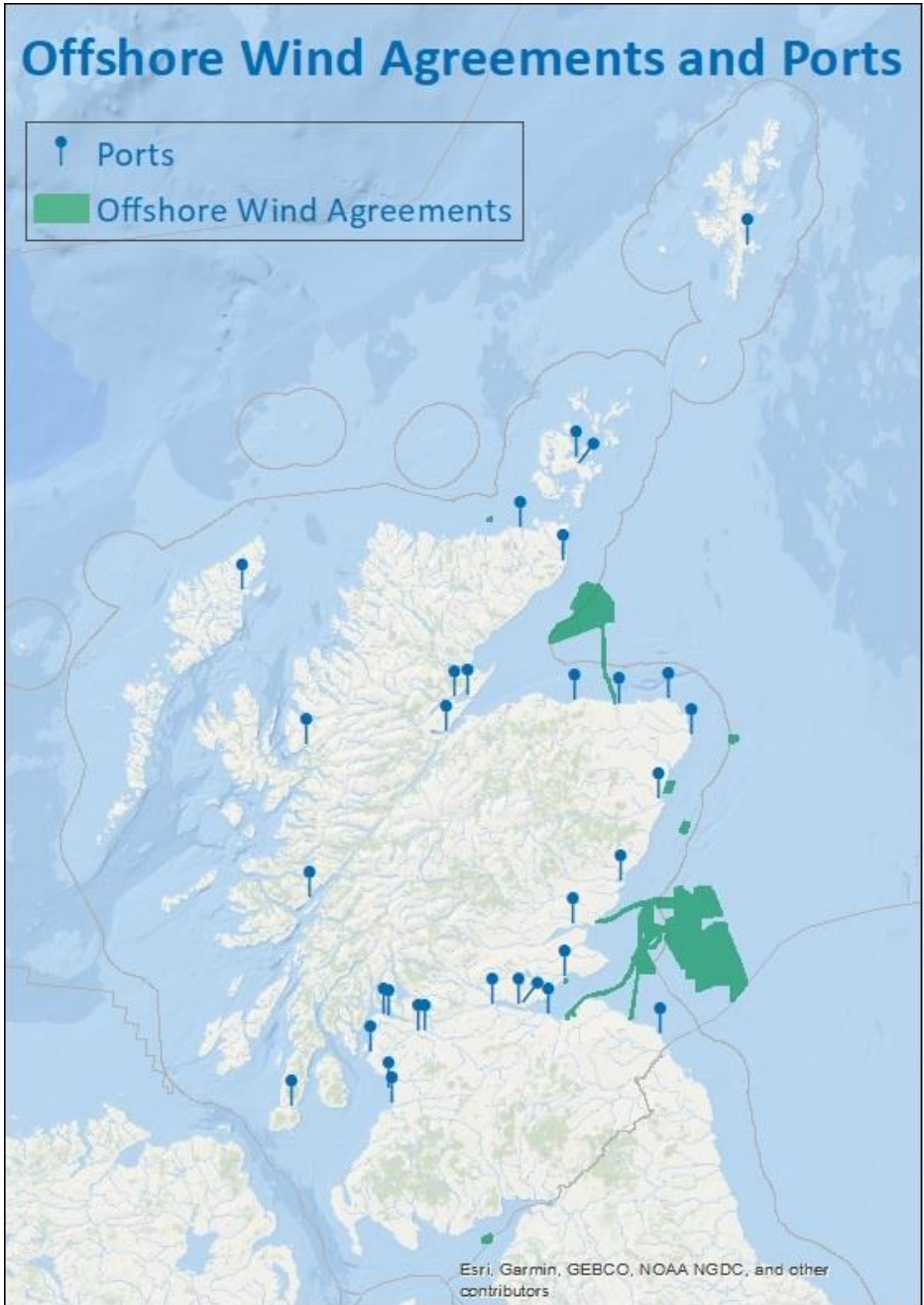

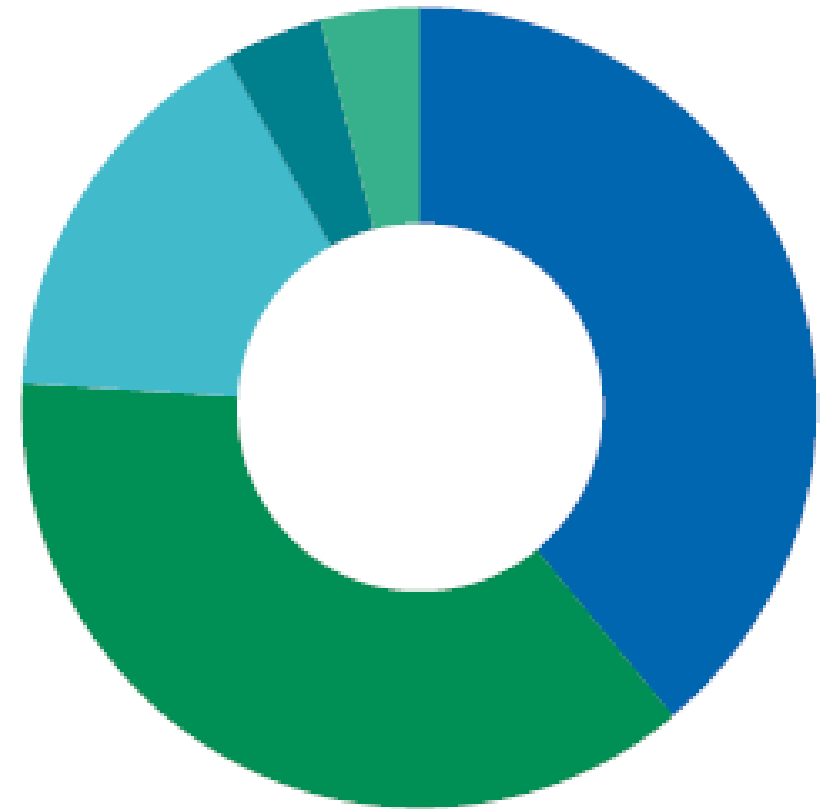
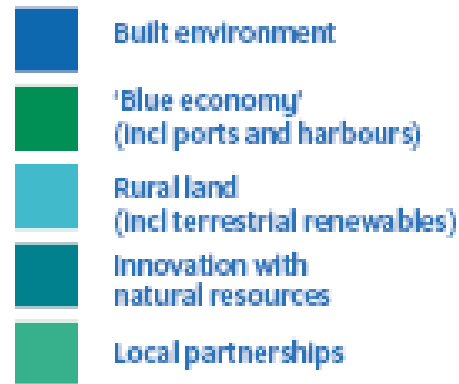
