### <u>Update for the Highlands and island Territorial Committee on the European</u> Maritime and Fisheries Fund

To provide an update on EMFF progress Scottish delivery to date.

#### Scotland:

- A total of £83m out of an EMFF budget of £90.7m has been committed to projects with verified spend of spend of £45m (54% of commitment) by the end of September 2019.
- Scotland's element of the UK EMFF programme has the highest commitment and certified spend figures.
- EU Commission confirmed at the recent annual performance review that the UK is in the top 3 EU countries in respect of commitments, spend and performance targets. Scottish funding is 46% of the UK programme.
- At present, except for UP6 IMP, funding for discretionary projects is almost fully committed with a further round for UP2 Aquaculture taking place at present.
- Continue to develop the large Integrated Maritime Policy (UP6) projects.
- N+3 targets covered in the second page have been met in all areas UP6.
   Scotland has provided covered for UK N+3 targets in UPs1-5 and the UK position on UP 6 IMP has meant that Scotland won't face de commitment for this UP.
- Movement in exchange rates may allow for some further "mopping up" commitments in 2020
- SG continues day to day claim monitoring and processing with all beneficiaries contacted regularly.
- DCF Scotland the 2015 and 2016 claims now verified;
- Scotland Compliance the 2015 Information Technology claim is finalised with the 2016 and 2017 claims also now verified;
