1. The Secure Care Strategic Board is due to report to Ministers by the end of December 2018.	Amber
Fiona Duncan wrote to Ms Todd in October 2018 to request the work of the Secure Board be brought in to the Independent Care Review (ICR). Taking in to account the increasing synergies between the work of the Independent Care Review and the work of the Board the Minister has agreed to the request. However Ms Todd has asked the board to complete their work on the Secure Care National Standards and the next round of commissioning.	
This took place as scheduled by the end of 2018. However, one consequence has been a delay to the finalisation of the Secure Care National Standards, as part of the workplan for the Independent Care Review. New timescales are currently being developed by Youth Justice colleagues.
