SIR,

I have the honour to submit, on behalf of the Fishery Board for Scotland, the Statistical Tables relating to the sea fisheries of Scotland for the year 1925. The Tables have been compressed and rearranged in accordance with the recommendations of a Sub-Committee of the Permanent Consultative Committee on Official Statistics. A narrative report on the fisheries and on the chief administrative and scientific activities of the Board during the year will shortly be submitted.

The Scottish fishing fleet in 1925 comprised 3,615 sailing vessels, 1,863 motor vessels, 809 steam drifters, 5 steam mussel dredgers, 48 steam liners as distinct from drifters, and 341 steam trawlers, or a total of 6,681 vessels, valued with their gear at £4,177,303, as against 6,834 vessels and £4,209,088 in 1924. In addition 275 English steam drifters fished in Scottish waters during the summer herring fishing. The number of Scottish fishermen was 27,141 (of whom 6,906 were crofter fishermen and 1,040 men were partially employed in fishing) as against 27,458 (including 7,309 crofter fishermen and 970 partially employed) in the preceding year. Shore workers and persons engaged in transport brought the total number employed in the Scottish fisheries to 66,844 as against 68,970.

The total quantity of fish landed in Scotland by British fishing vessels during the year was 5,713,685 cwts., valued at £4,454,163, besides shell-fish valued at £100,200, as against 6,996,387 cwts., £4,647,858 and £106,999 respectively in 1924. In addition 1,047,002 cwts., valued at £541,506, were landed by foreign fishing vessels, mostly German trawlers engaged in the Icelandic fishing, as against 979,783 cwts. and £512,122 in the preceding year, making a grand total of 6,760,687 cwts., valued with shell-fish at £5,095,874, as compared with 7,976,170 cwts. and £5,266,979 in 1924. Herrings figured most prominently in the aggregate landings, contributing 3,188,588 cwts., valued at £1,733,044, against 4,504,940 cwts. and £1,865,802.

The total quantity of herrings cured, kippered, &c. amounted to 884,867 barrels (of which 707,661 were pickled gutted), valued after cure at £2,512,804, against a total of 1,395,331 barrels valued at £3,348,433 in 1924. Of other kinds of fish the quantity cured, chiefly by smoking or drying, amounted after cure to 533,739 cwts., valued at £1,121,780, as against 500,086 cwts. and £1,038,107 in 1924.

The exports of fish from Scotland comprised 697,605 barrels of herrings gutted and pickled, 724 barrels ungutted, and 78,779 crans sprinkled with salt or iced, as against 1,182,832 barrels, 12,148 barrels, and 51,106 crans respectively in 1924, and 267,951 cwts. of dried or pickled fish of other kinds, and 15,655 cwts. of fish preserved in other ways, as against 232,941 cwts. and 25,536 cwts. respectively in 1924.
