## FOREWORD

**Fish Landed.** The total quantity of wet fish landed in Scotland by British vessels during the year was 9,016,629 cwt. valued at £57,280,186 compared with 9,386,136 cwt. valued at £53,059,874 in 1973. The quantity of shell fish landed was 377,264 cwt. valued at £6,781,617 compared with 473,053 cwt. valued at £7,771,752 in 1973. In addition 458,324 cwt. of wet fish valued at £1,797,276 and 17 cwt. of shellfish valued at £167 was landed by Belgian, Danish, Faroese, Icelandic, Norwegian, Polish and Swedish fishing vessels as against 630,257 cwt. of wet fish valued at £1,716,208 in 1973, making a grand total of 9,474,953 cwt. of wet fish valued at £59,077,462 (1973 10,016,393 cwt. valued at £54,776,082) and 377,281 cwt. of shell fish valued at £6,781,784 (1973, 473,430 cwt. valued at £7,775,738). Herring landed by British vessels amounted to 2,547,594 cwt. valued at £11,833,054 as against 2,860,901 cwt. and £8,629,017 in 1973, and demersal fish landed by British vessels amounted to 5,162,258 cwt. valued at £43,333,794 compared with 5,165,620 cwt. valued at £42,414,802 in the previous year. Foreign fishing vessels landed 92,559 cwt. of herring compared with 131,673 cwt. in 1973 and 341,008 cwt. of demersal fish compared with 466,093 cwt. in 1973.

**Fish Processed.** The quantity of herring kippered, pickle-cured, canned or marinated was after process 658,447 cwt. valued at £10,875,009 compared with 695,987 cwt. valued at £9,730,426 in 1973. Of other kinds of fish, the quantity processed, chiefly by smoking or canning amounted after process to 254,353 cwt. valued at £8,024,614 as against 251,722 cwt. and £6,437,791 in 1973.

**Fishing Fleet.** The Scottish fishing fleet at 31st December 1974 comprised 107 trawlers over 80ft., and 2,647 other motor vessels, a total of 2,754 vessels compared with 2,689 vessels in 1973.

**Fishermen.** The total number of Scottish fishermen at 31st December 1974 was 9,571 of whom 1,399 (including 248 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing. The number of fishermen at 31st December 1973 was 9,647 of whom 1,336 (including 253 crofter fishermen) were only partially employed in fishing.

**United Kingdom Statistics.** For convenient reference United Kingdom statistics are shown in Table 1. Statistics in all other Tables relate solely to Scotland.

## EXPLANATORY NOTES

### Landings

The quantities are expressed in terms of the landed weight. In the case of demersal fish (excluding Norway Pout) this is for head on, gutted fish; for other species including shellfish it is for whole ungutted fish.

### Fishing Vessels

Unless otherwise stated, fishing vessels are shown in registered lengths.

### Dover Sole and Porbeagies

From 1st January 1974, the landings of Dover Sole and Porbeagies have been included with "Other Demersal".

### Sandeels

From 1st January 1974 the landings of Sandeels have been recorded separately, instead of with "Other Demersal" as previously.

### Horse Mackerel

From 1st January 1974 the landings of Horse Mackerel have been recorded separately, instead of with "Other Pelagic" as previously.

### Queen Scallops and Whelks

From 1st January 1974 the landings of Queen Scallops and Whelks have been recorded separately, instead of with "Other Shell" as previously.
