## Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

## In the week ending $6^{\text {th }}$ June

 2021:- The rate of testing was $1,186.5$ per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was $6.5 \%$ in those aged 2-17 years; an increase from $5.9 \%$ last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 94.5 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 125.6 cases per 100,000 511 year olds, 149.7 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 201.4 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 98.6.

On $8^{\text {th }}$ June:

- Attendance in local authority schools was $89.6 \%$, whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was $7.9 \%$, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was $2.5 \%$.
- 16,508 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid19 related reasons.
