

Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic


In the week ending 11th July 2021:

- The rate of testing was 944.6 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 22.8% in those aged 2-17 years; an increase from 19.7% last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 162.3 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 266.1 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 454.9 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 928.9 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 332.
- This week, 607 (4.6%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 26% response rate].




Percentage of tests that had a positive result for COVID-19 over time, by age group
