As at 13th September 2020:

 There have been 554 children and young people aged 2-17 years in Scotland who have tested positive for COVID-19 since the start of the outbreak.

In the week ending 13th September 2020:

 There were 68 children and young people aged 2-17 years in Scotland who tested positive for COVID-19, among the 7,067 children and young people who were tested.

On 15th September:

- Attendance in local authority schools was 93.2%, whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 5.5%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 1.3%.
- 9,193 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons.
- 1,441 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 917 were teaching staff and 524 were other schoolbased staff.
- 75,275 children were attending a childcare setting and 812 had a Covid-19 related absence.
- 265 (1.5%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 45% response rate].
