
Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

In the week ending 19th September 2021:

- The rate of testing was 2,492.1 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 19.2% in those aged 2-17 years; a slight decrease from 19.4% last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 259.0 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 945.9 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 1,589.3 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 1,479.9 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 471.9.

On 21st September:

- Attendance in local authority schools was 89.5%, whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 7.5%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 3.0%.
- 20,928 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons. Of these, 5,594 were not in school because of a Covid-19 related sickness.

- 2,598 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 1,529 were teaching staff and 1,069 were other schoolbased staff.
- 54,186 children were attending a childcare setting and 1,338 had a Covid-19 related absence. Note that not all open settings completed the survey and that these figures are an underestimate of the actual number of open settings and children attending.
- This week, 596 (2.7%)
 childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 52% response rate].
