## Covid-19 Education Recovery Group - Infographic

In the week ending 23rd May 2021:

- The rate of testing was 1,029.9 per 100,000 children and young people aged 2-17 years.
- The percentage of tests that were positive was 4.8\% in those aged 2-17 years; an increase from 4.5\% last week.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 48.7 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 98.7 cases per 100,000 511 year olds 93.3 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 76.1 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 46 .

On $25^{\text {th }}$ May:

- Attendance in local authority schools was $90.1 \%$, whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was $8.1 \%$, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was $1.8 \%$.
- 12,004 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid19 related reasons.

- 1,259 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 777 were teaching staff and 482 were other schoolbased staff.
