



In the week ending 23rd January 2022:


- The percentage of tests that were positive was 35.6% in those aged 2-17 years.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 1312.5 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 2793.9 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 1507.7 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 830.8 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 939.5.



- Attendance in local authority schools was 87.8% whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 7.6%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 4.6%.
- 32,133 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons. Of these, 13,676 were not in school because of a Covid-19 related sickness.

- 4278 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 2,457 were teaching staff and 1821 were other schoolbased staff.
- 58,333 children were attending a childcare setting and 3064 had a Covid-19 related absence. Note that not all open settings completed the survey and that these figures are an underestimate of the actual number of open settings and children attending.
- This week, 1,746 (8.6%)
 childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 56% response rate].
