







On 30th November:

- Attendance in local authority schools was 89.2% whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 8.6%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 2.1%.
- 14,101 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons. Of these, 3,259 were not in school because of a Covid-19 related sickness.

- 2176 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 1,351 were teaching staff and 825 were other schoolbased staff.
- 50,265 children were attending a childcare setting and 985 had a Covid-19 related absence. Note that not all open settings completed the survey and that these figures are an underestimate of the actual number of open settings and children attending.
- This week, 521 (2.6%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 47% response rate].
