
In the week ending 6th February 2022:


- The percentage of tests that were positive was 25.1% in those aged 2-17 years; a decrease from 37.6% in week 04 in 2022.
- The identified COVID-19 positive cases reflected a rate of 612.4 cases per 100,000 2-4 year olds, 1633.1 cases per 100,000 5-11 year olds, 1025.9 per 100,000 12-15 year olds and 807.2 cases per 100,000 16-17 year olds. The rate of cases per 100,000 of the general population was 812.6.

On 8th February:

- Attendance in local authority schools was 88.9% whilst the percentages of openings recorded as pupils not in school (non Covid-19 reasons) was 8.1%, and for not in school (Covid-19 related reasons) was 3.1%.
- 20,185 pupils were not in school either all or part of the day because of Covid-19 related reasons. Of these, 8,479 were not in school because of a Covid-19 related sickness.


Percentage of PCR tests that had a positive result for COVID-19 over time, by age group

- 4,051 staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons, of which, 2,464 were teaching staff and 1,587 were other schoolbased staff.
- 57,472 children were attending a childcare setting and 1596 had a Covid-19 related absence. Note that not all open settings completed the survey and that these figures are an underestimate of the actual number of open settings and children attending.
- This week, 1079 (4.9%) childcare staff were absent due to Covid-19 related reasons [based on a 52% response rate].

For any LAs that were unable to submit their latest information on time, or for other reasons (e.g. due to local holidays/in-service days), then their previously submitted figures have been carried forward in order to produce an estimated total number of staff absent for Scotland.
 As such, week on week comparisons should be made with some caution as there will be some variation in the number of staff absent with confirmed Covid-19 or with symptoms of Covid-19 symptoms but are absent because they are self-isolating / shielding / quarantining / looking after someone due to Covid-19
