The Education (Disability Strategies)(Amendment)(Scotland) Regulations 2002

The Scottish Ministers, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 3(6) and 5 of the Education (Disability Strategies and Pupils' Educational Records)(Scotland) Act 2002^(a) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consulting such representatives of responsible bodies and with such other persons (or their representatives) likely to be affected by the Regulations as appeared to them to be appropriate, in accordance with section 5(3) of the said Act, hereby make the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Disability Strategies) (Amendment) (Scotland) Regulations 2002 and shall come into force on .

2. Regulation 3(h) of the Education (Disability Strategies) (Scotland) Regulations 2002^(b) is hereby revoked.
