As a south-west coaster used to seeing kittiwakes on the nest as a child, I am greatly saddened by the loss of such a sight. To imagine the further loss of familiar species is heartbreaking.

Since the decline in numbers of these birds is largely due to starvation of chicks in the nest, there has to be consideration given to supporting sandeel populations close to breeding sites.

I urge you to designate the Firth of Forth Banks Complex as recommended by the Joint Nature Conservancy Council and Scottish National Heritage.

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Sandeels play such a key role in the survival of many marine life-forms in this area, not least the seabird population which require much greater consideration in the list of designated features for protection in this site. Seabird feeding grounds need to be given higher priority, particularly where the feeding of chicks is concerned. In addition to sandeel fishing regulation, I would also ask that, in this respect, more sensitivity is given to the siting of offshore windfarms and other marine energy generators.



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## **Final Thoughts**

35.On the basis of your preferences on which pMPAs should be designated, do you view this to form a complete or ecologically coherent network, subject to the completion and recommendations of SNH's further work on the 4 remaining search locations?



#### Comments

I quote from your own document "With the exception of black guillemot, seabirds have not been included in the list of MPA search features in Annex 3. However seabirds are recognised as an intrinsic and valuable part of Scotland"s marine ecosystem and the list of MPA search features includes features which help to support seabird life stages."

I am deeply concerned that you have restricted your proposed protection for seabirds to Black Guillemots when their populations appear to be more stable than the others I have mentioned in Questions 2,3,6,13,19,21. I cannot concede therefore that you have adhered to the international agreement to create a complete or ecologically coherent network. Since a common factor in the decline of the species mentioned appears to be starvation of chicks on the nest due to parent birds' inability to reach their preferred foodsource (sandeels) with sufficient regularity their foodsource, and since I can find no mention of this species among marine lifeforms in Annexe 3, I fear that you have overlooked a key element in the marine ecosystem.
