

This note summarises employment, unemployment and economic Inactivity sourced from the Labour Force Survey for Scotland and the UK. These are classed as National Statistics.


This release follows the ONS monthly release of Regional Labour market Statistics in the UK

This month data are presented for the 3 months to December 2019, compared with the quarter before (July to September 2019) and compared with a year before (October to December 2018). Please note percentage point changes are based on unrounded data.

The employment rate in Scotland was 75.0 per cent. This is 0.6 percentage points up on the quarter and 0.5 percentage points down on the year.

The UK employment rate was 76.5 per cent. This is 0.4 percentage points up on the quarter and 0.6 percentage points up on the year.

Key findings

Labour Force Survey October-December 2019

The unemployment rate in Scotland was 3.5 per cent. This is 0.5 percentage points down on the quarter and no change on the year.


The UK unemployment rate was 3.8 per cent. This is 0.1 percentage points down on the quarter and 0.2 percentage points down on the year. 10 -

The inactivity rate in Scotland was 22.2 per cent. This is 0.2 percentage points down on the quarter and 0.5 percentage points up on the year.


The UK inactivity rate was 20.5 per cent. This is 0.3 percentage points down on the quarter and 0.4 percentage points down on the year.


