

SCOTTISH VICTIMISATION TELEPHONE SURVEY

QUESTIONNAIRE AND USER NOTES

This document provides the full SVTS questionnaire, including all questions asked of respondents, as well as notes and instructions to guide the reader.

The SVTS questionnaire consists of two elements:

1. The main questionnaire (sections 1, 2, 4, and 5) consists of a set of core modules asked of the whole sample, including the victim form screener (section 2) and demographics (section 5);
2. A victim form (section 3) which collects details about the incidents a respondent may have experienced during the reference period (the 12 months prior to the month of interview). This victim form can be repeated up to five times; the number of victim forms completed depends on the number and nature of incidents respondents experienced;

Each of these elements and the sections they contain are presented in the table of contents after this introduction.

The following conventions are used in this document:

- The question label (and generally SPSS variable name) is shown to the left in **BOLD CAPITALS**;
- Question text for interviewers to read out to the respondent is shown in bold text;
- The routing / filtering instructions for the question are displayed above the question text in **CAPITALS**;
- Instructions to interviewers are written in **CAPITALS**;
- Instructions to CAPI scripters are written in **BLACK BOLD CAPITALS** and do not display on screen;
- Text substitutions in question (and sometimes code) text are denoted by the symbols < > with alternate substitutions separated by a /. (The specifications for text-substitutions are not shown in this document for simplicity.)

Commonly used notation includes:

- **SINGLE CODE ONLY** means that only one response option can be coded.
- **MULTICODE OK** allows more than one response option to be coded;
- **RANDOMISE** means that the response options are randomised each time they appear on screen;
- <INSERT DATE> refers to the start of the 'reference period' – the first day of the month 12 months prior to the month of interview (see section 5.1 of the Technical Report for further detail).
- Other (**SPECIFY**) within the code frame denotes that the respondents answer is recorded by the interviewer.

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INTRODUCTION

TIMESTAMP START

My name is from Ipsos MORI, the independent research organisation.

You may remember that in <MONTH AND YEAR OF PREVIOUS SURVEY> you took part in the Scottish Crime and Justice Survey, for the Scottish Government, which asked about your views and experiences of crime and justice in Scotland.

IF NECESSARY: An interviewer would have called at your home and interviewed you using a laptop computer, with the interview lasting about 40 minutes.

At the end of the interview you said you would be happy to be re-contacted for follow-up research. I am calling you now to see if you would be willing to take part in a short follow-up survey for the Scottish Government which would be conducted by telephone. You should have received a letter from us to let you know that we would be contacting you.

This survey will ask about any crime you may have personally experienced over the last 12 months, and also about your perceptions of crime, safety and the police. The survey will NOT include questions about drugs, harassment and abuse which you might remember you completed yourself the last time. The interview length depends on the answers you provide but on average lasts 20 minutes.

IF HAVE NOT RECEIVED LETTER: I can email you a copy of the letter if you like?

And I would like to assure you that all the information will be kept in the strictest confidence by the Scottish Government and used for research purposes only. It will not be possible to identify any particular person, household or address in the results. Would you be happy to take part?

ADD IF RESPONDENT THINKS THEY ARE NOT RELEVANT FOR THE SURVEY AS THEY HAVE NOT BEEN A VICTIM OF CRIME: It is important that we speak to those who haven't been victims of crime as well as those who have. This gives the Scottish Government a more complete picture of crime rates in Scotland than police figures alone, especially during the coronavirus pandemic, since not all crime is reported to the police.

ADD IF RESPONDENT FEELS THEY MAY HAVE TO ANSWER UNCOMFORTABLE QUESTIONS: You will be able to refuse to answer any questions you feel uncomfortable answering as we go through the interview. But we do hope you can take part because it is important that we interview a range of people across Scotland so we get a true picture of crime and gather a range of views about crime and justice.

ADD IF RESPONDENT QUERIES HOW THE DATA IS USED: Although the Scottish Government commissions the Scottish Crime and Justice Survey, there are other groups who use the results too. For example, interest groups such as victim support groups, criminologists and academics, and the police force.
